This event is open to all USBC sanctioned bowlers who are in good standing age 19 and under as of August 1, 2022.

Individuals will bowl 6 games (scratch) on the designated Kegel or similar sport pattern. **There will be separate boys and girls divisions (U12, U15, U18 and U20) provided there are a minimum of 3 bowlers of each gender participating.**

All award monies will be deposited in the USBC SMART program (#12093). **No cash awards are available to any bowlers.**

No entry will be accepted without payment. Walk in entries will be allowed subject to lane availability and close 15 minutes prior to the start of the event. Tournament management has the right to reject any entry. Credit card payments will be subject to a \$3 service charge.

Dress code: No T-shirts, sweat shirts, tank tops, yoga pants or hats. Girls may wear pants, dress shorts (fingertip length) or skirts (golf skirts are recommended over tennis skirts). Boys may wear dress pants or dress shorts (golf shorts are recommended - no cargo or similar styled shorts with external pockets). No apparel may be worn referencing illegal drugs, alcohol, tobacco, obscenities or offensive content.

No electronic devices are to be used during competition.

ALL scores must be verified by a fellow participant during competition. Failure to do so will result in a score of ZERO being recorded.

Score corrections: Bowlers *MAY* correct scoring errors provided that another competitor acknowledges the scoring error. The correction must be completed prior to the next bowler throwing a ball on that lane.

Tiebreaker: In the event of a tie for any scholarship, the highest game bowled will be used until the tie is broken. If all scores are equal, the scholarship will be divided equally.

Disputes: Only a participating bowler may approach tournament management to discuss alleged rule violations. Parents, coaches and spectators will not be heard. Protests must be filed in accordance with USBC Rule 329.

The tournament manager has the final decision with any rules not covered above.
